Crime Prevention Awareness for the Licenced Premises Industry

Course Background

This Crime Prevention awareness training course has been designed to provide staff with an understanding of the types of crimes that can occur within the Licensed Premises Industry. Attendees will appreciate that the inviting social settings that attract people of all ages can be a lucrative environment for the motivated or indeed casual offender to commit crime. While customers are relaxed and chatting their awareness of, and the implications of being a victim of crime are dramatically reduced which in turn presents opportunities for criminals to commit crime.

Purpose

During this half day training course attendees will appreciate that simple actions can have a significant impact on crime. Being vigilant to the arrival of persons who may be intent on committing crime by increasing their general awareness of the possible signs that criminals may present. Attendees will also have an understanding of the various tactics that criminals use to commit crime.

This Crime Prevention awareness training course will provide staff with a greater understanding of crime and the use of positive early intervention tactics in addition to positive engagement with customers which can all lead to reducing the consequences and effects of crime within licensed premises.

- Suspicious criminal activity body language; the unusual/protracted interest in the presence of/and placement of CCTV, an interest in staff practises within public and private space ... victim selection!
- The 10 Principles of Crime Prevention key focus on strategies particular to the Licensed Premises Industry
- Staff vigilance, positive actions to deter crime on Licensed Premises
- Role play scenarios safe evidence gathering opportunities
- Course evaluation and debrief
